PEDIATRIC PHYSICAL THERAPY

Sage Care physical therapists develop activities that help children and young adults improve movement and mobility; develop strength, balance, coordination, and motor learning, and to promote childrens' active participation at home, in school and in their community.

PEDIATRIC OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Sage Care occupational therapists help their patients master the jobs of being children: playing, going to school (if they are able), socializing with others, and taking care of themselves to their fullest ability. Children also work on sensory processing and develop adaptive behaviors to improve their ability to participate in the activities of daily living.

PEDIATRIC SPEECH THERAPY

Sage Care speech therapists work with children to develop verbal and non-verbal communication skills, including speech production, articulation and understanding and expressing language. They also help patients improve their ability to eat. Speech therapists help children strengthen their mouth muscles, chew, swallow, improve tongue movement, improve their ability to suck and drink, accept food, and become accustomed to a variety of foods.
